## **SUN TRAN RELEASES FALL ROUTE & SCHEDULE CHANGES**

TUCSON, AZ - On August 17, 2003, Sun Tran bus routes and schedules will be modified to offer passengers a more efficient, customer-friendly system. Significant changes to routes and schedules include the following:

- Route 61 has been extended to serve Shannon Road between Ina and Magee Roads. This extension will allow passengers access to the Pima Community College Northwest Campus and the Northwest YMCA.
- In order to accommodate the demand for increased service during the school year, Routes 3, 4, and 15 will return to 15-minute frequency during peak hours.

Service on Davis Monthan Air Force Base has been permanently discontinued due to security measures communicated by the U.S. Department of Defense. Buses on Route 34 will operate as far south as 30th Street at Craycroft Road.

Other route schedules have been adjusted to improve on-time performance. A new edition of the Sun Tran Ride Guide is now available to offer passengers detailed route and service changes. The Fall/Winter 2003 Ride Guide is effective August 17, 2003 through February 21, 2004.

The Sun Tran Ride Guide is available on buses, at transit centers, pass sales and information outlets throughout Tucson, and at Sun Tran's administrative offices, located at 4220 South Park Avenue.
