SUN TRAN'S UA FOOTBALL SHUTTLE BEGINS THIS WEEKEND

TUCSON, AZ - Sun Tran will offer shuttle service to and from the University of Arizona vs. University of Texas El Paso football game this Saturday. Wildcat fans can ride the Sun Tran Shuttle to all the home games this season, and avoid the hassle of getting trapped in traffic.

Round-trip full-fare is \$2.00. Round-trip half-fares are \$1.00 for seniors 65 years of age or older, individuals with disabilities, and Medicare cardholders. Children 5 years of age and under ride free. Shuttle tokens will be available for each game at the following boarding locations:

- Tucson Mall, east of American Home Furnishings
- Fry's Shopping Center, at I-19 and Irvington
- Hi Corbett Field, in front of the main entrance.

Shuttles begin leaving the boarding locations two hours before kick-off and run continuously until the beginning of the game. Passengers will arrive in front of Arizona Stadium on 6th Street. To return to boarding locations, riders may begin boarding the buses on 6th Street at the start of the fourth quarter. Buses leave as they fill.

Sun Tran's community event shuttles are sponsored this season by: O'Reilly Chevrolet, Arizona Lottery, Tucson Newspapers, KB Home, and Carondelet Health Network.
