SUN TRAN FALL/WINTER RIDE GUIDE NOW AVAILABLE

TUCSON , Ariz. – A new edition of the Sun Tran Ride Guide is now available offering passengers detailed route and service changes effective August 13, 2006 through February 17, 2007.

In order to accommodate the demand for increased service during the school year, Routes 3, 4, and 15 will provide more frequent service during peak hours.

Sun Tran is pleased to launch the first project of the RTA plan on August 14, with additional bus trips scheduled to serve passengers where overcrowding has occurred on a regular basis for several years. Additionally, stand-by buses will be positioned throughout the service area on a daily basis, assisting with overcrowding situations where possible.

The Sun Tran Ride Guide is available on buses, at transit centers, pass sales and information outlets throughout Tucson, and at Sun Tran's administrative offices, located at 4220 South Park Avenue.
