SUN TRAN SPRING/SUMMER RIDE GUIDE NOW AVAILABLE

TUCSON, Ariz. - A new edition of the Sun Tran Ride Guide is now available offering passengers detailed route and service changes effective February 19 through August 12, 2006.

- Schedules on Routes 34 and 83 have been modified to improve on-time performance.
- For customer convenience, the Ride Guide now provides information on interlines. This means on certain trips, a bus serving one route will continue on as another route at the end of the line. Since more than half of Sun Tran's routes interline, it is possible that a rider who normally takes two buses to make a one-way trip can make that trip using just one bus without a transfer. Interlines are utilized to make our system more efficient, providing better service to our passengers.
- As a result of passenger input, the Ride Guide now has easy-to-read timetables and larger font, making it easier to use. Sun Tran would appreciate feedback on this issue and any suggestions passengers have to continue improving this publication.
