## **OUTPOURING OF GENEROSITY FOR SUN TRAN "STUFF-THE-BUS"**

Tucson, Arizona - Through the cooperative efforts of Sun Tran, KGUN 9 News, Clear Channel Communications, Sam Levitz Furniture, and the American Red Cross, the Tucson community raised a total of \$27,400 worth of in-kind and monetary donations that will benefit firefighters and victims of the Aspen Fire.

On June 25, the Tucson area offered overwhelming support of the "Stuff-The-Bus" donor drive. Sun Tran buses located at two Sam Levitz locations overflowed with \$20,000 worth of water, toiletries, clothing, and a wealth of other much needed items to comfort firefighters and evacuees. The American Red Cross collected a total monetary donation of \$7,400 at the "Stuff-The-Bus" locations. In addition, an anonymous financial gift of \$20,000 was made at the Tucson office on the day of the "Stuff-The-Bus" drive.

"We thank all of our partners and the community for making this effort such a success," said Sun Tran General Manager George G. Caria.

Sun Tran is Tucson's local public transportation system, which is operated by the City of Tucson and managed by Professional Transit Management, Ltd. (PTM).
