Sun Tran Service Accommodates Holiday and Summer Schedules

TUCSON, ARIZONA - In observance of Memorial Day, Sun Tran will operate all routes on a Sunday bus schedule Monday, May 26. On the following day, changes to Sun Tran's weekday service for three routes will become effective May 27 through August 17.

Route 3 (6th Street/Wilmot), Route 4 (Speedway), and Route 15 (Campbell) will be changed to accommodate the fluctuating demand for bus service during the summer. Buses traveling along Routes 3 and 15 will operate every 30 minutes, while Route 4 will operate every 15 minutes.

"This is simply a change in service that coincides with the summer vacation of local school districts," said Sun Tran General Manager George G. Caria.

For Memorial Day:

- Sun Tran Express Routes will not be operating.
- The Ronstadt Transit Center information booth will be open from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Information booths at Tohono Tadaí and Laos Transit Centers will be closed.
- Buses will serve all three transit centers.
- Customer Service Representatives will be available from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at 792-9222 (TDD: 628-1565).
- Sun Tran's administrative offices, including Lost and Found, will be closed. All offices will re-open Tuesday, May 27.
