SUN TRAN BUSES WILL OPERATE ON A SUNDAY SCHEDULE ON THANKSGIVING DAY

Free Bus Passes Available for Salvation Army Dinner beginning November 24

Tucson, Arizona - Sun Tran buses will operate on a Sunday schedule on Thursday, November 27, in observance of Thanksgiving Day:

- The information booth at Ronstadt Transit Center will be open from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- A Customer Service Representative will be available from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. to assist passengers with their trip planning needs. The Customer Service Center number is 792-9222. The Customer Service Center will re-open on Friday, from 6 a.m. until 7 p.m.
- The information booths at Roy Laos and Tohono Tadaí Transit Centers will be closed. All three transit centers will re-open on Friday, November 28, at 6:30 a.m. until 6:15 p.m.
- The Administrative Offices and Lost and Found, located at 4220 South Park Avenue, will be closed. The Administrative Offices will re-open on Friday, November 28, at 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. and Lost and Found will re-open at 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

For the fifteenth year, Sun Tran and the City of Tucson are donating bus passes for free rides to the Salvation Army's Annual Thanksgiving Day Dinner at St. Demetrios Greek Orthodox Church. Free Sun Tran bus passes are available on a first-come, first-served basis beginning Monday, November 24, at the Salvation Army's Administrative Office located at 1001 N.
