WHAT IS TITLE VI?

Title VI is part of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, stating no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

1. MAJOR SERVICE CHANGE

2. FARE CHANGE

3. DISPARATE IMPACT

4. DISPROPORTIONATE BURDEN

1. MAJOR SERVICE CHANGE

IF EITHER 25% INCREASE OR DECREASE FROM LAST FISCAL YEAR IN REVENUE MILES OR 25% INCREASE **OR** DECREASE FROM LAST FISCAL YEAR IN REVENUE HOURS **THEN** EVALUATE IF THE CHANGE HAS A DISPARATE IMPACT OR A DISPROPORTIONATE BURDEN?

IF YES - REEVALUATE THE CHANGE IF CHANGE IS RECOMMENDED START THE PUBLIC HEARING PROCESS

2. FARE CHANGE

PUBLIC HEARING IS TO BE HELD IF ANY FARE CHANGE IS TO OCCUR

EVALUATE IF THE CHANGE HAS A DISPARATE IMPACT OR A DISPROPORTIONATE BURDEN?

IF YES - REEVALUATE THE CHANGE IF CHANGE IS RECOMMENDED START THE PUBLIC HEARING PROCESS

3. DISPARATE IMPACT

- * IDENTIFIES IF THERE IS AN ADVERSE EFFECT FOR A MAJOR SERVICE OR FARE CHANGE THAT DISPROPORTIONATELY AFFECTS MINORITY POPULATIONS' MORE THAN NON-MINORITY POPULATIONS
- * IF THE CITY OF TUCSON FINDS A POTENTIAL DISPARATE IMPACT, WILL TAKE STEPS TO AVOID, MINIMIZE OR MITIGATE IMPACTS THEN REANALYZE THE MODIFIED SERVICE PLAN TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE IMPACTS WERE AVOIDED, MINIMIZED OR MITIGATED
- * A DISPARATE IMPACT OCCURS IF A PROPOSED MAJOR SERVICE AND/ OR FARE CHANGE REQUIRES A MINORITY POPULATION TO BEAR ADVERSE EFFECTS BY TWENTY PERCENT (20%) OR MORE THAN THE ADVERSE EFFECTS BORNE BY THE NON-MINORITY POPULATION

4. DISPROPORTIONATE BURDEN

- * IDENTIFIES WHEN ADVERSE EFFECTS OF ANY MAJOR SERVICE AND/OR FARE CHANGE ARE BORNE DISPROPORTIONATELY BY LOW-INCOME POPULATIONS
- * IF THE CITY OF TUCSON FINDS A POTENTIAL DISPROPORTIONATE BURDEN, WILL TAKE STEPS TO AVOID, MINIMIZE OR MITIGATE IMPACTS THEN REANALYZE THE MODIFIED SERVICE PLAN TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE IMPACTS WERE AVOIDED, MINIMIZED OR MITIGATED
- * OCCURS IF A PROPOSED MAJOR SERVICE AND/ OR FARE CHANGE REQUIRES A LOW-INCOME POPULATION TO BEAR ADVERSE EFFECTS BY TWENTY PERCENT (20%) OR MORE THAN THE ADVERSE EFFECTS BORNE BY THE NON-LOW-INCOME POPULATION
