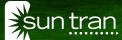

## **Sun Van's New Vehicles**

#### Sun Van Introduces New Vehicles, Including First Electric Vans in Arizona

On October 3, Sun Van hosted a press event featuring remarks from General Manager Mikel Oglesby and Assistant General Manager Panya Chhoeuy to showcase five all electric vans and 50 new vehicles, expanding their fleet with cleaner, more modern, and more accessible rides for the community. All vehicles including the electric vans feature lifts. While the electric vans can accommodate up to six passengers or three wheelchairs, the others can carry eight passengers and two mobility devices, including scooters.

Funded by a \$12 million Low or No Emission Grant in 2022 and \$3 million in local contributions by City of Tucson, Tucson Electric Power (TEP), Pima Association of Governments (PAG), and the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA), this \$15 million retires 42 older vehicles and advances Sun Van's commitment to sustainability, reliability, and improved rider experience.





#### **New Decal Promotes Operator and Passenger Safety Awareness**

"Assaulting a Driver is a Felony" decals promote awareness of safety and serve as a reminder that assault is a felony. Our operators are protected through reference Arizona House Bill 13-1203. The decals are located at the window by the front door. The message reminds passengers that any disorderly, threatening, or assaultive behavior toward operators or others on the bus is subject to criminal prosecution. This is an important step in promoting a safe and respectful environment for all. By raising awareness of the law, Sun Tran aims to deter disruptive behavior, keep those who keep our community moving safe and ensure that riders enjoy their trips.

# In the Community

#### **Young Riders Excited About Transit**

Sun Tran visited Safford School to host a Learn to Ride session for students in kindergarten through fifth grade. During the event, students learned the basics of using public transit including how to ride the bus safely, how accessibility features work, and a bit about Sun Tran's history serving the Tucson community. The highlight of the day was a hand-on walkthrough aboard a Sun Tran bus, where students practiced what they learned and explored the bus firsthand. By teaching young riders about public transit early, we help create lifelong transit users and build a stronger connection between Sun Tran and the communities we serve.



#### White Cane Day 2025

In recognition of White Cane Day, Sun Tran hosted an educational session at the Arizona School for the Deaf and Blind, to give students a hands-on experience to public transportation. The session featured both a Sun Tran bus and a Paratransit Sun Van allowing students to explore the vehicles up close, learn how to navigate the transit system, and foster independence through mobility. This highlights Sun Tran's commitment to making transit accessible for all and empowers every member of the community to travel safely, confidently and independently.

#### **Spooky Spirit Season**

Sun Tran and Sun Van each celebrated Halloween with festive events that brought together employees and their families for some spooky fun. At Sun Tran's Boo Town more than 100 employees and their families enjoyed pizza, music, games, and trick-or-treating through creatively decorated department haunted houses. At Sun Van, employees hosted a Spooky Potluck featuring themed treats and a costume contest. Staff had the opportunity to dress up while on the job, giving riders a spooktacular transit experience.

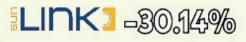

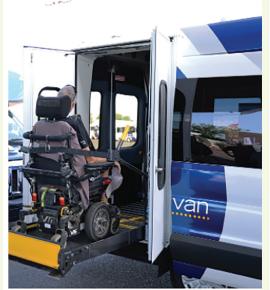

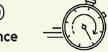

#### Glossary of Terms

Cancellations (Sun Van) When the passenger or the passenger's representative cancels the reservation two or more hours prior to the beginning

of the scheduled pick-up time.

**Complaints per 100,000 Passengers** Equals total complaints divided by total passengers times 100,000.

**Cost per Mile** Equals total operating expenditures divided by total miles.

**Cost per Service Hour** Equals total operating expenditures divided by total service hours.

**Cost per Trip (Sun Van)**Total operating expenses divided by total trips.

**Deadhead Miles and Hours**Miles that a vehicle travels when out of revenue service. Deadhead includes leaving or returning to the garage or yard

facility, changing routes or when there is no expectation of carrying revenue passengers. Deadhead does not include

operator or maintenance training.

No-Shows (Sun Van) When the passenger does not board the Sun Van vehicle when the vehicle arrives at the pick-up location within the pick-

up window and the driver waits two minutes, or when the customer does not cancel the reservation within two hours of

the scheduled pick-up time.

Optional ADA (Sun Van) Passenger trips outside 3/4-mile corridors around Sun Tran fixed routes or beyond times availbale on a Sun Tran fixed

route, a same day request, and will calls.

Passengers per Mile Equals total passengers divided by total revenue miles.

**Passengers per Service Hour** Equals total ridership divided by total service hours.

#### Glossary of Terms

Pick-Ups Before Significantly Late (Sun Van) Pick-ups 30 minutes outside of the originally scheduled pick-up window.

Revenue Miles and Hours The miles and hours that vehicles travel while in revenue service. Vehicle revenue miles and hours (VRM and VRH)

include layover/recovery time but exclude deadhead, operator training and maintenance testing.

Ridership (Unlinked Passenger Trips)

The number of passengers who board public transportation vehicles. Passengers are counted each time they board

vehicles no matter how many vehicles they use to travel from their origin to their destination.

Ridership (Unlinked Passenger Trips) Sun

Van

Equals Total passengers actually transported. A one-way trip taken by an ADA paratransit-eligible passenger, a personal

care attendant (PCA) or companions from the pick-up point to the destination.

Service Miles and Hours

Miles and hours that vehicles travel while in revenue service plus deadhead miles/hours. Service miles/hours does not

include operator or maintenance traing.

**Total Demand (Sun Van)**Total number of passenger trips requested.

**Total Cost per Passenger** Equals total operating expenditures divided by total passengers.

**Trip (Sun Van)**A one-way trip taken by an ADA paratransit-eligible passenger from the pick-up point to the destination (excludes PCA's

and companions).

**Trip Time (Sun Van)**The percentage of ADA trips with a trip time less than the comparable Sun Tran fixed route trip.

**Trip Time 110% + 5 Minutes (Sun Van)** When an ADA trip length exceed 110% + 5 minutes of the comparable Sun Tran fixed route trip.
